

Community Fire Pit Waiver

Please read & sign the community fire pit prior to use.

The fire pit must be supervised by someone who is at least 18 years of age & older at all times.

INITIAL

Fires cannot start before 10:00am and must be extinguished by 10:00pm. The benches and fire pit are closed from 10:00pm to 7:00am and are monitored by security cameras.

INITIAL

Only clean/dry firewood is permitted to be burned in the fire pit. Do not burn wet, treated/painted wood, garbage, rubber, plastic, leaves or yard waste. Wood ad branches from the surrounding area are not permitted for use.

INITIAL

Please use our metal bucket and water from Policeman's Creek to extinguish the fire completely. The ashes are required to be cold prior to leaving the fire. Please put the metal bucket inside the grate, close the grate and lock the padlock. Turn the padlock upside down to lock.

INITIAL

Renter MUST abide by all bylaws and COVID-19 restrictions set out by the Alberta Government and AHS. If the party is found to be breaking any rules, bylaws and/or restrictions, a fine will be applied to the credit card on file.

INITIAL

The fire pit key must be brought back to the Spring Creek Vacations office and dropped through the mail slot

INITIAL

I / we hereby follow the fire pit regulations, AHS health and safety guidelines and restrictions and I / we will respect the Spring Creek Community Fire Pit and understand that fines upwards of \$2000 will be enforced by Spring Creek and / or Town of Canmore if regulations are violated.
